



Intermittent Lane Closures & Overnight Full Closures on Highway 1 in Kicking Horse Canyon in July 2021

Kicking Horse Canyon Constructors (KHCC) will continue implementing evening intermittent single-lane closures and overnight full closures on Trans-Canada Highway for the Kicking Horse Canyon Phase 4 construction throughout July 2021. KHCC will implement intermittent single-lane closures weekly from Sunday night to Friday night. KHCC will also continue to implement overnight full closures from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. (MDT) Sunday night to Friday morning for the month.

INTERMITTENT LANE CLOSURES

KHCC requires evening lane closures Sunday, July 4th to Saturday, July 31st weekly from Sunday to Thursday from 8:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. (MDT) and Friday evening from 8:00 p.m. to Saturday morning at 7:00 a.m. (MDT) for the month of July. Expect up to 30-minute travel delays due to single-lane alternating traffic at the construction site.

OVERNIGHT FULL CLOSURES

KHCC requires overnight full closures Sunday, July 4th to Friday, July 30th weekly from Sunday to Thursday from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. (MDT). During the overnight full closures, the highway will be closed between Golden and the project limits west of the Kicking Horse Rest Area.

During these periods, the alternate route of Highways 93S and 95 will be available for travelers to choose, which will add up to 90 minutes to travel time.

CANADA DAY LONG WEEKEND (July 01 to 04, 2021)

Please note that there will be no closures or stoppages due to construction during the Canada Day long holiday weekend, from Wednesday, June 30th at 12:00 p.m. to Sunday, July 4th at 8:00 p.m. (MDT) to ensure motorists are not affected by construction over the long holiday weekend.

These full closures and intermittent lane closures are part of a traffic-management strategy developed in consultation with the community and key stakeholders. This strategy is designed to minimize travel disruptions during the peak summer and winter travel periods by having as much work as possible done at night and other off-peak periods.

Traffic Impacts & Accommodation

- 30-minute travel delays due to single-lane alternating traffic (intermittent lane closures) at the construction site.
- During the overnight full closures there will be emergency responder access from both ends, but no through traffic available to the public.
- Both approaches to Kicking Horse Canyon will be well-signed and traffic control personnel will be onsite to direct traffic as required.
- Drivers are reminded to obey construction-zone speed limits and the direction of traffic control personnel.
- The alternative traffic route via Highway 93S and Highway 95, with an additional driving time of approximately 1.5 hours, is available.
